

Official Rules
Power Tour Two-Night Getaway Sweepstakes
April 15, 2010

1. The Mobile Bay Convention and Visitors Bureau will conduct a contest from Friday, April 16, 2010 through Tuesday, June 1, 2010. Prizes have been supplied by the Mobile Bay Convention and Visitors Bureau and the Holiday Inn Downtown Mobile in exchange for promotional consideration.
2. No purchase is necessary to enter.
3. One (1) Grand Prize will be awarded. The Grand Prize includes one hotel room for the nights of June 10th & 11th, 2010 at the Mobile/Downtown Holiday Inn, a VIP Pass for a family of four (4) to Mobile, Alabama area attractions, and a Mobile Bay "Go Coastal" gift bag.
