Magnolia Grove

Part of the famous Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail offering 36 holes of championship play. An additional 18-hole par 3 venue. Site of the Nike Tour Championship in 1998 and LPGA's Golf Champions tournament in 1999



Timber Creek Golf Club

An Earl Stone design with 27 holes of championship golf. Rolling Hills, hardwoods and fantastic facilities. Very playable. Four star rated by Golf Digest.

Azalea City Golf Club

One of the nation's great municipal layouts, recently renovated and in magnificent condition. Host to the Mobile Open, a onetime PGA event won by Billy Casper, Arnold Palmer, the late Tony Lema and Gay Brewer.



Rock Creek Golf Club

Another Earl Stone design, Rock Creek offers 18 holes over scenic hills and natural hazards. Great service has earned this facility four stars from Golf Digest.



Marriott's Lakewood Golf Club

Located in the nearby Point Clear at Marriott's Grand Hotel, this venue has 36 holes set in an emerald pine forest and moss-draped oaks. Original design by Perry Maxwell, renovated by Ron Garl. A bay-side setting once the host of Shell's Wonderful World of Golf televised golf matches.

The Woodlands at Craft Farms

This Larry Nelson designed layout is neatly manicured and is a favorite on the Coast. Reminiscent of coastal Carolina courses, The Woodlands features lakes, marshlands and hardwood-lined fairways.

Cypress Bend at Craft Farms

This Arnold Palmer designed challenge features wide fairways that wind through a setting of glistening lakes, sprawling bunkers and lush marshlands. A spectacular layout.



Cotton Creek at Craft Farms

The jewel of the Gulf Coast, Cotton Creek is a Palmer designed layout featuring rolling hills and large greens. Challenging, but very fair, this course gives golfers of all skills a chance to card a good score.

Peninsula Golf Club

This Earl Stone design in Gulf Shores follows the natural terrain through lakes and wetlands. Close attention was paid to these oversized greens, creating tournament quality, gently sloping putting surfaces.



Gulf Pines Golf Club

Very playable course with wide open fairways, but small tricky greens. Located on Mobile Bay, Gulf Pines offers scenic views and a chance for a really good score. Convenient to the downtown area from I-10.

Linksman Golf Club

Challenge, Beauty & Quality - *Challenge* - 18 holes, 72 par, 6400 yard layout. *Beauty*-scenic Dog River's winding canals. *Quality*-experienced professionals ensure every round is memorable. Open for daily play and to groups for private outings. Golf packages available.



Quail Creek Golf Course

Nestled in beautiful Fairhope, an attractive and challenging 18-hole course with three lakes and over 40 sand traps, great driving range and full-service grill. Regulation 72 par course with a friendly, well trained staff led by former PGA tour professional Alan Pate. Located 15 minutes from Foley and 25 minutes from Mobile.
